

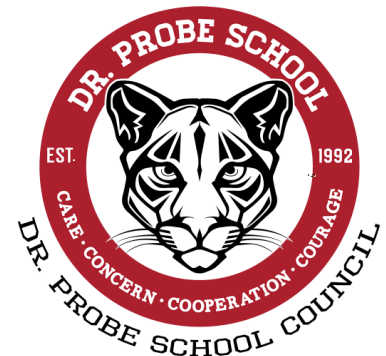

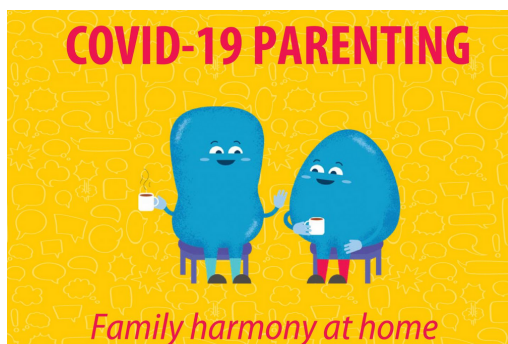

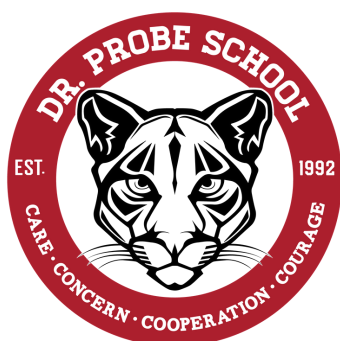


KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION
